Devotional

Psalm 71:17 reads, "O God, from my youth you have taught me, and I still proclaim your wondrous deeds." This verse reminds me about the importance of teaching the Word of God to children, so that it is a part of who they are as adults. Many of the giants of the faith in the Bible learned God's truth in their youth. Luke 2:41-50 tells about when Jesus was twelve and the time He spent in the Temple, listening to teaching, asking questions, and answering questions: "And all who heard him were amazed at his understanding and his answers" (Luke 2:47). In Acts 23, Paul recounts how he was "educated at the feet of Gamaliel according to the strict manner of the law of our fathers, being zealous for God ..." (Acts 23:3b). Finally, Paul refers to the childhood faith of Timothy: "I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice" (2 Timothy 2:5a). God tells parents to teach their children about His commandments: "You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise" (Deuteronomy 6:7). The Psalmist, Jesus, Paul, and Timothy, have all made a lasting impact upon the world today because they lived out as adults the faith they learned as a child. Our kids can do the same thing today and change the world for the cause of Christ.
