Luke 10:27 is the perfect summary of the 10 Commandments in Exodus 20:1-19. The first four commandments (Exodus 20:3-11) are concerned with how our love for God is demonstrated. These four commandments are summarized in Deuteronomy 6:4-5, "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might." The last six commandments (Exodus 20:12-17) are concerned with how we love our neighbor and are summarized in Leviticus 19:18, "You shall not take vengeance or bear a grudge against the sons of your own people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself: I am the Lord." We must first love our God with all of our being before we even begin to truly love our neighbor. The more we practice loving God, the more we will be able to love our neighbor as ourself.

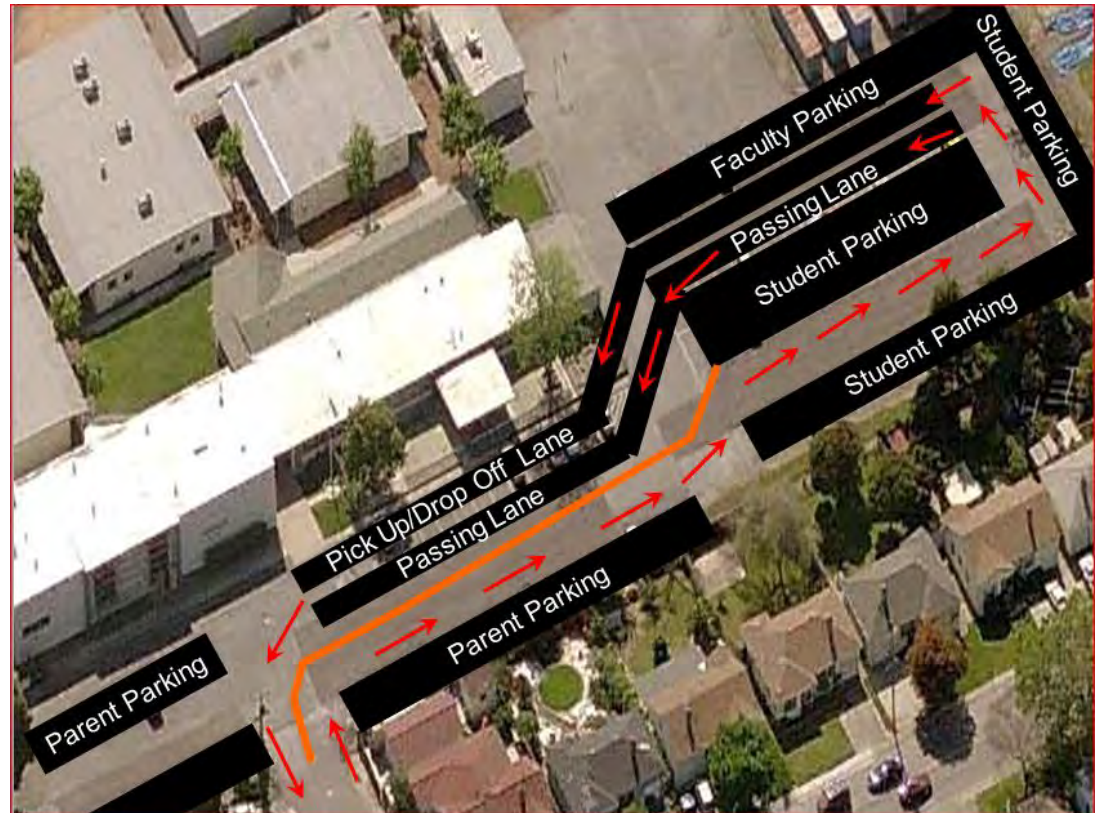

MSHS Parking Lot Instructions

Parents, thank you for being **PATIENT and COURTEOUS** in the parking lot, it easily becomes congested. To help the traffic flow as smoothly as possible, we are asking you to please observe the following guidelines:

- **DO NOT DRIVE IN THE EXIT**
- ONLY DROP YOUR CHILD OFF IN THE DESIGNATED PICKUP/DROP OFF AREA in front of the school
- Be patient and courteous when dropping off and picking up your children
- Make the full loop and do not cut through the student parking spaces
- Keep moving forward in the pick-up lane (the right lane)
- **Drive over the speed bumps at a slow speed.**
- Do not cut through the cones
- Do not pick up or drop off from the passing lane (the left lane) or the parent parking
- Do not park in the student parking spaces, in the passing lane, or the pickup lane
- **DO NOT ALLOW YOUR CHILD TO WALK ACROSS THREE LANES OF TRAFFIC.**
