In Exodus 9:16, we read: “But for this purpose I have raised you up, to show you my power, so that my name may be proclaimed in all the earth.” Let’s be clear about this passage: the purpose referred to here is the Israelites undergoing tremendous suffering during the plagues in Egypt, only to be brought out by God’s power. This brings to light a critical truth: we are going to suffer and, in fact, are naturally inclined to do so. But in the difficulties of life, or of plagues, famine, and hail storms, God shows us His power so that we can trust in Him and proclaim His goodness. God is good all of the time. Whether we are in suffering or not, God’s power is enough for us. The Israelites had the opportunity to learn this great lesson, and we do as well. In Christ,
