"Fabulous Five" As Reported by RCS Teachers:

1. Mrs. Grunow reports, "A group of boys was working on a main idea using pretend billboards, a new activity, to describe something and give it a title. One student had a particularly difficult time but did not give up. I asked him if he was having an easier time towards the end. "Yes," he said, "I know if I keep at it I will get it." Go growth mindset."
2. Mr. Summers reports, "In my Bible class, students wrote diary entries similar to what CS Lewis did in 'The Screwtape Letters' pretending to be Satan. They wrote about four different targets who had different beliefs. I could see the lights turning on as they considered how various religions and philosophies blind people's eyes to the truth of the gospel."
3. Mrs. Vincent reports, "Using the reading strategy "double entry, sentence starters" for the English Immersion students, they were able to increase their comprehension and quiz scores by 15%."
4. Mrs. Conley reports, "Twice a week, during POWER (Put Off Work. Everybody Read), students have been allowed to "Partner Read." Students each have their own copy of the same book and take turns reading pages."
5. Mrs. Benefiel reports, "After learning about Helen Keller, the 2nd Graders were intrigued to try "reading" words on each other's palms...without the use of their vision!"
