## Fabulous Learning

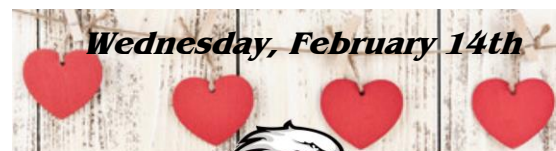
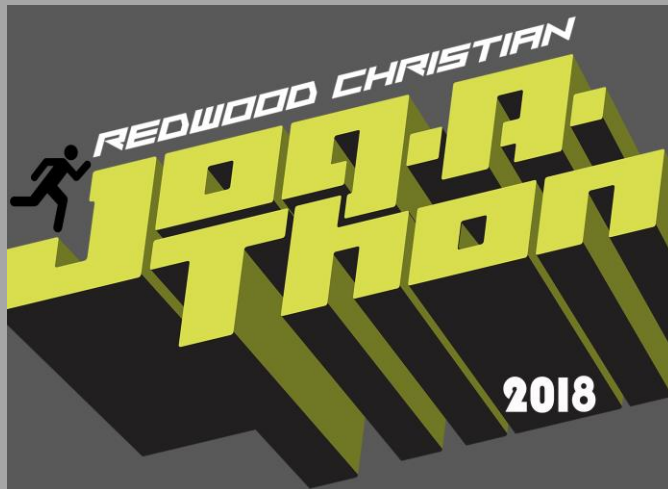
