Barbara and Kent invited other camper families -- the Dockas and the Thompsons – who helped co-host the first two events. (Taylor Docka and Charlie Thompson are campers.)

“Basically, we often talked about a Kentucky Derby party and then Kent found this amazing betting software. It uploads all 5 afternoon races, including the actual derby. Guests can bet on all of the races. The software automatically keeps 20% of the winnings for “the house.” That made us think about how we can donate that additional money and we immediately thought of camp! We donate the house money, and our generous friends often just donate their winnings. Some just write checks, too. This was our 3rd party, and Kudzu has always been where we have donated.

We went to family camp three times, (Evan was too young for actual camp), then Evan went to Sprouts camp and this summer will be his 4th year at Twin Lakes. We have met so many amazing people, our incredible babysitter among them, all through camp. We have seen the confidence it creates in these children with type 1, and it is such a gift for them.

Basically, we love to entertain, and we love Camp Kudzu, and hope that we can provide scholarships for a few kids by putting these both together!”
