One of the 25 grants awarded this year will go to green infrastructure work in Cities Initiative member city, Hamilton, Ontario. A local environmental organization has received the funding to complete nine green infrastructure projects that aim to improve stormwater management by increasing stormwater storage to up to 130,000 gallons annually. Through rain gardens, removal of impervious surfaces, and community engagement, the projects aims to reduce contaminated stormwater entering Spencer Creek and Hamilton Harbour.

The program builds community capacity to advance wetland, forest, riparian and coastal habitat restoration. The Sixteenth Street Community Health Center was awarded the grant to restore seven acres of riparian area along the Kinnickinnic River. 
## As part of organization development under our CS Mott Foundation grant, staff recently participated in a staff retreat.
