Our Purpose

Guiding Question: *Does our current middle schedule still best meet the needs of our students?*

2017–2018 School Year:

The plan for the 2017–2018 school year contains two parts:

1. Adopt a predictable schedule for the 17–18 school year. The schedule will contain a fixed rotation of a 3 and/or 4 block structure.
2. Continue examination of time allotted to subject areas, use of X-Block and staffing allocations at the middle level.

What work has been accomplished to address our guiding question?

Fall 2015: The middle school schedule needed adjusting to allow for the addition of a new course at each grade level and a new staff member to service all three grades. This led to the convening of a middle school schedule committee to explore possibilities for a new middle school schedule.

Summer: 4 meetings to develop options for staff to review

Fall: staff review/discuss options for refinement

November: staff continue dialogue around options

December: presentation to EDCO on work to this point

January: presentation to PTA on work to this point. Committee continues to look at options for implementation

February: Presentation to staff

February: Presentation to Cabinet

March: Presentation to Board of Education

Current Flexible Block Schedule

“A” Blocks: Fine Arts, PE, Global Language

“B” Blocks: Reading, Writing, Math, SS, Science

“B” Block teachers have a set number of minutes each day to divide. This allows for

- longer and shorter classes depending on the needs of the curriculum.
- students to have classes at different times during the day.

- ❑ PE 42 minutes everyday
- ❑ Fine Arts and Global Language (GL) 42 minutes every other day. FA rotates by trimester (drama/art/music)
- ❑ Lunch/Recess 30 minutes every day
- ❑ X Block 30 minutes every day
- ❑ B block for Math, SS, Sci, Reading, Writing
 - 4 block days=56 minute classes
 - 3 block days=76 minute classes

- GL 42 minutes everyday
- Fine Arts and X Block 42 minutes every other day. FA rotates by trimester (drama/art/music)
- Lunch/Recess 30 minutes every day
- B block for Math, SS, Sci, Reading, Writing
 - 4 block days=51 minute classes
 - 3 block days=70 minute classes

X Block (excel, explore, extend, expand)

History...

- Implemented in the 2008–09 school year to support students in a variety of ways through both remediation and enrichment

How it is used...

- Formal Interventions
- Remediation
- Situational Academic Support
- Situational Executive Functioning Support
- Supporting Social-Emotional Needs of Middle Schoolers** (Erin's Law, Erika's Lighthouse)
- Enrichment opportunities (coding, election unit, etc...)
- Team/Building Admin. Activities (celebrations, admin talks, guest speakers, etc.)

Plan moving forward...

- The middle schools will engage in an evaluation of X Block to ensure that there are consistent program goals and implementation guidelines across both schools.

Variations looked at through our committee work

No X-Block

Plus:

- Additional minutes can be dedicated to other classes

Delta:

- Need to find a time for student interventions (during FA, GL, SS)
- Need to find a time to teach Fine Arts
- Need to reinforce SEL across all grades and subjects
- No remediation offered during the school day
- What to do opposite global language in 6th grade
- 5 or 6 PE classes at a time

Variations looked at through our committee work

A/B Day Model

Plus:

- Predictable schedule
- Increase in math minutes
- No increase in FTE
- Long blocks of class time
- Daily math

Delta:

- Reduction in ELA, Science, SS minutes
- There could be potential changes in teaching assignments

Variations looked at through our committee work

Humanities/STEM

Plus:

- Predictable schedule
- Increase in math minutes
- Increase in science minutes

Delta:

- Shorter SS classes (36 minutes)
- Students travel as groups from class to class
- There could potentially be a change in teaching assignments

Variations looked at through our committee work

Math Off-Team

Plus:

- Predictable schedule
- Increase in math minutes (53 minutes every day)
- Daily Math
- PE teachers teach 5 classes
- Math teachers teach 4 classes

Delta:

- Increase in FTE
- Reduction in GL minutes (53 minutes every other day)
- Math teachers not at team meetings
- PE four days a week (same amount of minutes)
- Math teachers teach multiple grades

Where are we going?:

- ❑ The principals will meet with the new superintendent to determine the long term outcomes and establish the clearly defined charge and timeline for the middle school scheduling committee.
- ❑ The principals will collaborate with staff to determine the steps necessary to implement the recommended schedule changes.
- ❑ A committee comprised of staff from both middle schools will be created to provide the principals with information about how X block is currently used and how it might be best used to support all students.
- ❑ Identify data sources and sets to inform future work
