In 2015, he became director of the La Salette Shrine in France. And now, he returns to Attleboro as Director of the La Salette Retreat Center and again as Director of the La Salette Missionary Association. Not as young as he was in 1969, but he returns to La Salette of Attleboro with a wealth of pastoral experience.
