It was common for we priests to hear, "Father it's been 30 years...40 years...50 years since my last confession." People heard the message of Pope Francis who said, "God never tires of forgiving us, it is we who tire of asking for forgiveness." People, young and old, wanted to take advantage of God's loving mercy so that they could begin again.

The Year of Mercy also reawakened the Catholic world to our great spiritual treasure "The Works of Mercy." Once they received God's mercy, many people realized it should not be kept to themselves. Around the world, people took extra time to feed the hungry, give water to the thirsty, clothe the naked, bury the dead, and visit the sick and imprisoned. 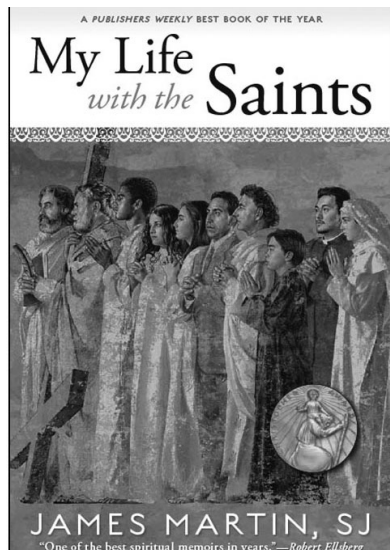

IN REMEMBRANCE OF OUR BELOVED DEAD

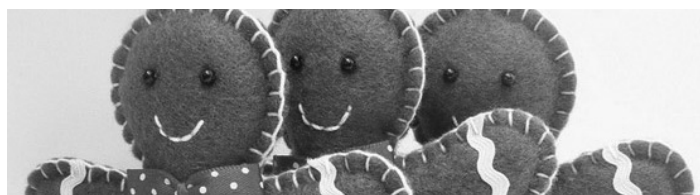
November 2, 2016 at the 12:10pm & 6:30pm Mass

Since 1994 the Watoto Children's Choirs have traveled as Ambassadors of the millions of African children in need of hope. Their audience comes from all walks of life, including the Queen of England, President George Bush, the UK, Australian, Canadian, Scottish parliaments, and the greater public, warming many hearts wherever they go. Based on the Biblical verse "See what kind of love the Father has given us, that we should be called children of God, and so we are" (John 3:1), "Oh What Love" presents the vitality of the new Africa. Like Africa, the children of the choir are representative of many others who are beginning to understand their identity in Christ and what He has called them to be. They know that they belong to a family of believers. Each of the children of the choir has suffered the loss of one or both of their parents. Through "Oh What Love" they present their stories of victory and new life as they demonstrate that God desires to be a loving Father to all mankind.

Make Your Weekly Offering Online

Although not everyone buys things online many people do. For those of you who do, we will begin to offer 'online giving' for your regular donation. In addition to the basket system you will now be able to select an amount you would like to give to the Shrine each week, set it, and forget about it. This amount will be put on your charge card or taken right from your bank account like other automated giving. We are now using a very secure system called the E-Catholic/Blue Pay System. Its security is twice that of Amazon and Paypal and use of this method has several advantages for both you and the Shrine.

After enrolling, you'll no longer have to remember to get your money ready at home or stop at the ATM before coming to Mass. You also won't have to search to find the pen to make out a check. If you forget to bring your money, you can still make a one time donation on your phone. We'll even give you a coupon so you still have something to put in the basket so you don't feel guilty when the basket is passed. With Blue Pay, you will also be able to register and buy tickets to different events for events at the Shrine online!

Of course we'll still take cash in the basket and candle money at the front desk.
