A LA SALETTE IS ON HIS WAY TO SAINTHOOD!

Pope Francis has confirmed the heroic virtues of 12 Servants of God in a decree promulgated by the Congregation for the Causes of Saints on May 19th among which is a La Salette:

FR. JEAN BAPTISTE BERTHIER, MS

The Founder of the Congregation of the Missionaries of the Holy Family, Father Jean Berthier, M.S., was born in Chatonnay, France, on February 24, 1840. John showed a desire for religious life when he was very young and prepared for the diocesan seminary by studying Latin. On October 23, 1858, at the age of 18, he entered the seminary in Grenoble with an ardent desire for holiness. During his vacation in 1861, he went to La Salette with six other seminarians. He already knew all about the apparition, having heard the story from his grandmother since he was six years old. "Once on the mountain," he writes, "the eyes of my head saw nothing special; but the eyes of my soul saw plenty. The thought that Mary had graced this place with her presence, that her tears had watered the ground on which I walked. The missionaries who, with unequaled fervor, were reciting their breviary. I was taken up by all this and, when it came time to leave, I said to myself: I shall come back here."

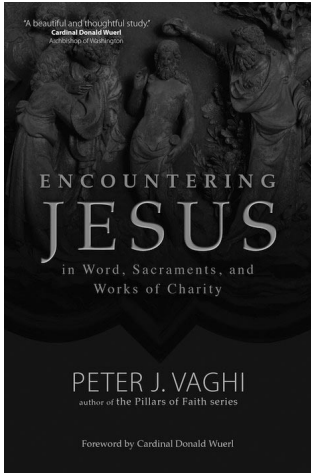
