

Otniel and Mildrey moved from Miami to Port Charlotte several years ago with the sole purpose of living in a quiet place so their children would have an opportunity to thrive. Initially Otniel traveled to his construction job in Miami and returned home on the weekends.

As Matthew grew, his needs became even greater. It was difficult for Mildrey to care for the children on her own. His needs became so severe that he is unable to have his photo taken (their last family photo was taken when he was one). Otniel left his job in Miami after he was able to find work locally, but making ends meet has become very difficult. Their current affordable rental is a small two bedroom house. The needs of their boys require them to have their own bedroom, leaving Otniel and Mildrey sleeping on a pull-out couch.
