

## William R. Griffith *signs* *The Battle of Lake George:*

*England's First Triumph in  
the French and Indian War*

Against all odds, in 1755, British Commander William Johnson rallied his men through the barrage of enemy fire to send the French retreating to Fort Ticonderoga. Historian William Griffith recounts this important event in U.S. and New York State history.
