

‘O Ka Lā Mei Ka Lā Lei Ma Hawai‘i

Ho‘ohanohano ‘ia nā kānaka a me nā hanana kūikawā ma Hawai‘i me ka lei. A ma ka lā 1 o Mei, no ka lei ka hanohano – ‘o ia ka Lā Lei ma Hawai‘i nei.

Ua kumu kēia ho‘olaule‘a ma kahi halepule ma Hawai‘i Mokupuni i ka makahiki 1901 – kahi i hīmeni mua ‘ia ke mele ‘o Nā Lei O Hawai‘i, he ho‘ohanohano iā Hi‘iakaikapoliopole a me kona huaka‘i mokupuni. Ua helu ia mele i nā lei mokupuni kekahi.

Ma nā makahiki ma hope mai, ua laha ia mele ma nā hō‘ike. Ma kekahi hō‘ike ma ka makahiki 1909, ua lei nā mea hīmeni i nā lei mokupuni a komo i nā waiho‘olu‘u mokupuni. Ma ka makahiki 1928 i mālama ‘ia ka Lā Lei mua ma Honolulu, ke kupuna ho‘i o nā ho‘olaule‘a o kēia mau lā.

Ua ulu a‘e nā ho‘olaule‘a ma nā kaiāulu a puni Hawai‘i, a ua mau ka Lā Lei mua loa no kanaiwa makahiki. E mālama ana nō ke Kalana O Honolulu i ka Lā Lei i kēia makahiki ma ka lā 1 o Mei ma ka Pāka ‘o Kapi‘olani ma Waikīkī, me ka ho‘okūkū haku lei, nā kālepa lei a hana no‘eau, ka hīmeni a me ka hula.
