

Call for Papers for a special session on
“Spatial CGE modeling and transport issues”
at The 57th European Regional Science Association (ERSA) Congress,
29 August-1 September 2017, Groningen, The Netherlands

Description:

Transport projects undoubtedly affect to the interaction between regions with respect to economic affair. Damage to transport infrastructure also influences the picture of economy. Spatial CGE models integrating transport system, or transport modeling, play substantial roles to measure the effects of above issues. Increased attention is being paid to performing economic evaluations of transport projects using SCGE models, not only in Europe but in Asia and America. This special session will cover theoretical, methodological, applied and practical issues related to SCGE and transport modelings.

- 3) Special Sessions should have a minimum of 6 contributions.
If a Special Session does not meet the above conditions, it will be included in the program as an O-session or an R-session.
