College Fellowship is geared toward people between the ages of 18 and 24, and it meets Wednesdays at 7:00 p.m. in the Youth Room in the Parish Hall. "I am very excited to see what the Lord will do in the lives of the college students that come on Wednesday evenings," said Streett. "Only a relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ is able to give them the purpose and meaning they so desperately long for."
