Fred Whittle is a native New Englander who attended The Citadel from 1976-1980, married a Beaufort girl in 1982, and adopted a Conway, SC, baby in 1995. He served in the Marine Corps from 1980-2000 as an infantry officer and later as an AV-8 Harrier "Jump Jet" pilot, flying 36 combat missions in the Persian Gulf War in 1991.

At The Citadel, Mr. Whittle was the Cadet Regimental Commander, editor of the campus newspaper, and a member of the Junior Sword Drill and Summerall Guard. He graduated magna cum laude with a B.S. in business administration. After spending two years as an Olmsted Scholar at the University of Augsburg in Bavaria, Germany, from 1986-88, he earned his graduate degree from The Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy, Tufts University, in 1993. In May of 2016, The Citadel awarded him an Honorary Doctor of Commerce.

Mr. Whittle's local civic duties include the Charleston Leadership Foundation's annual prayer breakfast, the Boy Scouts, three Exchange Clubs, and college fundraising. He is currently Vice President and Chief Operating Officer of Jupiter Holdings, LLC, and he has published numerous opinion editorials for The Post and Courier and Charleston Mercury newspapers, covering political, economic, ethical, and leadership subjects. Mr. Whittle is a member of the vestry of St. James (Anglican) Church, and he and his wife, Susan, have one son, 22-year-old Wilkerson.
