Community Needs Assessment

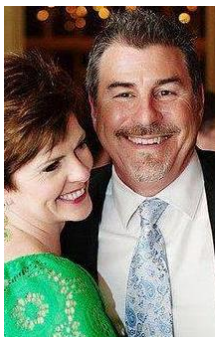
