Wildflowers and Sedges/Grasses – quart sized pots -- \$4.50

Trees/Shrubs and Vines – quart sized pots -- \$6.00

--gallon sized pots -- \$7.50

To ensure you are able to get plants you know you want, please pre-order. However, there will also be a selection of plants to purchase at this time. **There will be gardening experts available to answer your questions about native plants—the how, where, why and when.**

- The plants available at LOWA's fall sale are top quality container grown plants from Prairie Hill Farm.
- Your purchase will help LOWA continue to educate Lake of the Ozarks residents on the preservation and protection of our lakes, streams and watershed.
