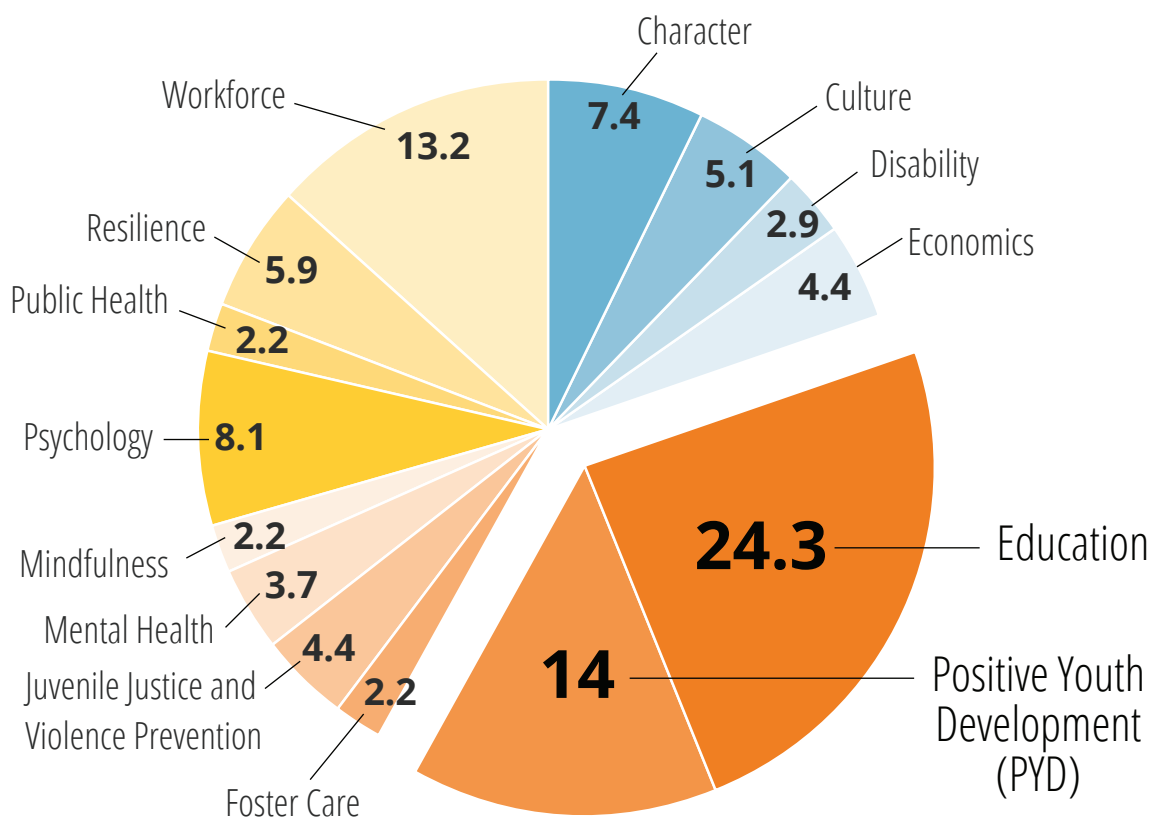


# MAPPING THE SEL LANDSCAPE

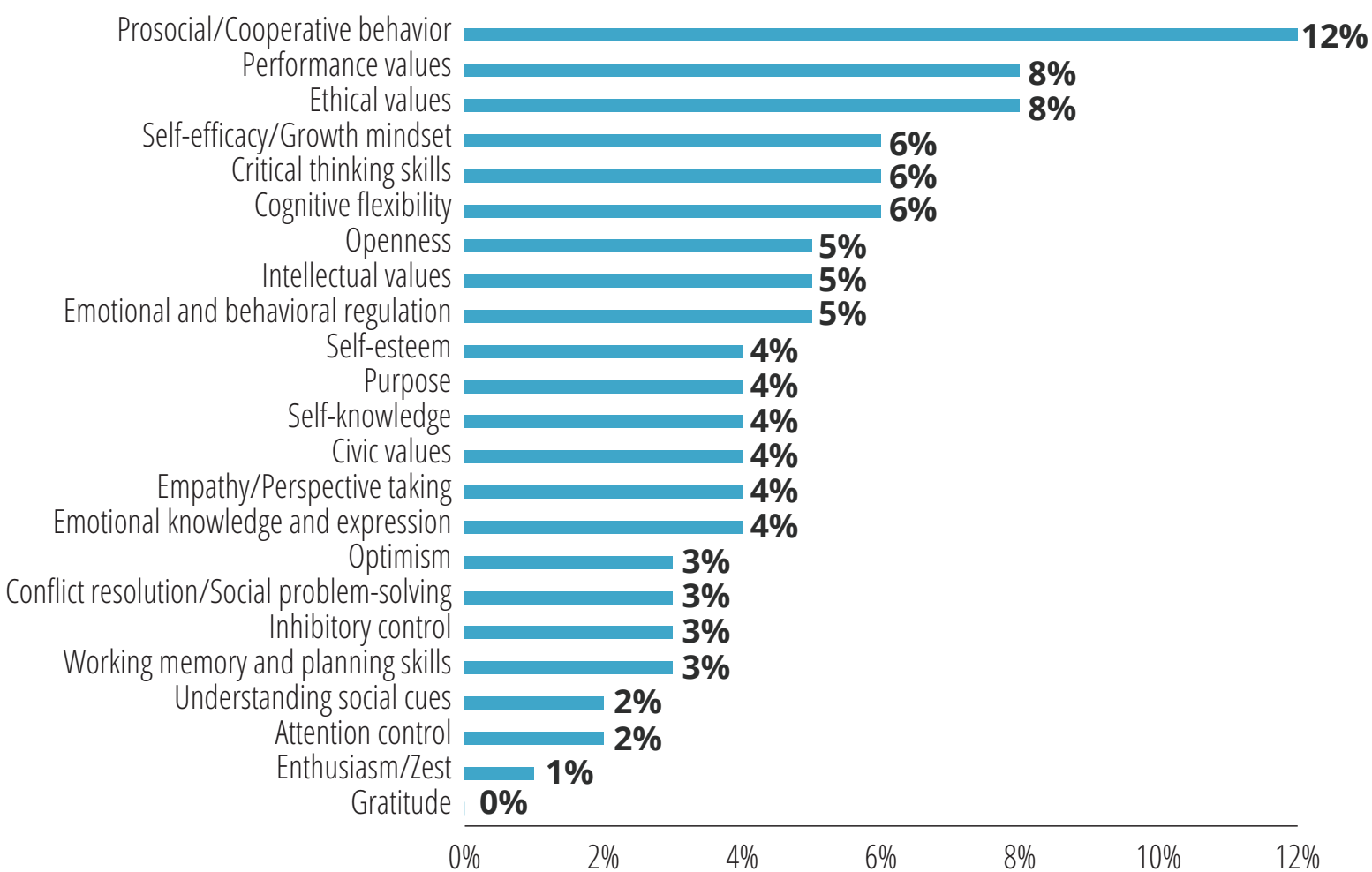
A new report from the American Institutes for Research identifies 136 different frameworks that cover social and emotional development, including CASEL's widely used wheel. More than one third of the frameworks come from the education and positive youth development fields.

## MOST PREVALENT COMPETENCIES

In all, the researchers identified 748 different competencies. Prosocial/cooperative behavior, ethical values, and performance values were the most prevalent. The research will have a major impact on the work of the Assessment Work Group, through which CASEL and other experts are exploring how best to measure SEL.



## MANY GAPS

Frameworks do not apply uniformly across individuals, groups, and systems.

Fewer than **20%** consider culturally and **linguistically diverse individuals and groups.**

Fewer than **20%** consider the experiences of **youth with disabilities.**

Just under **6%** acknowledge **trauma experiences.**

Fewer than **10%** outline the **developmental sequence of competencies.**
