## **Communication: October 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup>**

### **October 1<sup>st</sup> – Psalm 19:14**

(ESV) “Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in your sight, O LORD, my rock and my redeemer.”

### **October 2<sup>nd</sup> – Psalm 37:30**

(ESV) “The mouth of the righteous utters wisdom, and his tongue speaks justice.”

### **October 3<sup>rd</sup> – Proverbs 12:25**

(ESV) “Anxiety in a man’s heart weighs him down, but a good word makes him glad.”

### **October 4<sup>th</sup> – Proverbs 25:11**

(ESV) “A word fitly spoken is like apples of gold in a setting of silver.”

### **October 9<sup>th</sup> –1 Corinthians 13:4-7**

**4 Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. 5 It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. 6 Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. 7 It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.**

### **October 10<sup>th</sup>- 1 Corinthians 1:10**

**I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another in what you say and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly united in mind and thought.**

### **October 11<sup>th</sup>- Joshua 24:15**

**But if serving the Lord seems undesirable to you, then choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you are living. But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord.**

### **October 12<sup>th</sup>-Acts 16:31-34 ESV**

**And they said, “Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household.” And they spoke the word of the Lord to him and to all who were in his house. And he took them the same hour of the night and washed their wounds; and he was baptized at once, he and all his family. Then he brought them up into his house and set food before them. ### **October 13<sup>th</sup> –Genesis 18:19 ESV**

**For I have chosen him, that he may command his children and his household after him to keep the way of the Lord by doing righteousness and justice, so that the Lord may bring to Abraham what he has promised him.”**

### **October 15<sup>th</sup> -Proverbs 15:27**

**27 The greedy bring ruin to their households, but the one who hates bribes will live.**

### **October 16<sup>th</sup> -1 Timothy 5:8**

**Anyone who does not provide for their relatives, and especially for their own household, has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.**

### **October 17<sup>th</sup> - Matthew 6:31-33**

**So don't worry about these things, saying, 'What will we eat? What will we drink? What will we wear?' These things dominate the thoughts of unbelievers, but your heavenly Father already knows all your needs. Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need.**

### **October 18<sup>th</sup> -1 Timothy 6:17**

**October 27<sup>th</sup> – 1 Corinthians 6:13-20**

**13** You say, “Food for the stomach and the stomach for food, and God will destroy them both.” The body, however, is not meant for sexual immorality but for the Lord, and the Lord for the body. **14** By his power God raised the Lord from the dead, and he will raise us also. **15** Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ himself? Shall I then take the members of Christ and unite them with a prostitute? Never! **16** Do you not know that he who unites himself with a prostitute is one with her in body? For it is said, “The two will become one flesh.” **17** But whoever is united with the Lord is one with him in spirit. **18** Flee from sexual immorality. All other sins a person commits are outside the body, but whoever sins sexually, sins against their own body. **19** Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; **20** you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies.

### **October 29<sup>th</sup> –**

**Ephesians 5:33 ESV**

**However, let each one of you love his wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband.**

**Colossians 3:19 ESV**

**Husbands, love your wives, and do not be harsh with them**

### **October 30<sup>th</sup> –**

**1 Peter 3:1 ESV**
