

Catholic theologian and conflict mediator Ann Garrido seeks to help faith leaders understand conflict as a blessing, as a way to facilitate conversation which leads to conversion and new identity. Her presentation will include:

- What makes for a Tough Conversation?
  Analyzing what makes difficult conversations.
- Talking about the "fact" in a difficult conversation
- What do feelings and identity have to do with it?

Recognizing that conflict serves as an opportunity to gain insight and understanding, this continuing education event will help you:

- Identify potential causes, manifestations, and negative impacts that can result from conflict.
- Hone skills that can be used to manage conflict effectively.
- Apply skills to manage conflicts while displaying respect for others and preserving relationships.
