

Directions to Whitman Hanson High School, 600 Franklin St, Whitman MA 02382

From the North: Take 93 to Rte 3 South to the Rte 18S (Weymouth) Exit. Follow Rte 18S to Rte 58 in Weymouth/Abington town line. Take a left onto Rte 58, follow Rte 58 through Abington into Whitman, take a right on Pleasant St, then continue straight onto Rt 27/Franklin St. The School will be on your LEFT behind the athletic fields

From the West: Take Rte 27 from Brockton

From the South: Take Rte 3N to Rt 3A/106 in Kingston. Following 3A/106 West until you get to Rt 27.

Follow Rte 27 west into Whitman, the school will be on your right just after you pass Rt 14.

From the East - Take Rte 14 until you get to Rte 27 intersection, take a right, school is on your right approximately one mile.



Electronic or amplified instruments will not be permitted. A tin whistle must have a metal body, a plastic tip and only six holes. A beginner is anyone who started playing a particular instrument after January 1, 2012. Beginners will play only one piece from one of the classifications below. Duets must have two different instruments & play two pieces of contrasting temp. Trios must have at least two different instruments & play two pieces of contrasting tempo. Entrants may compete in only one category for each instrument. entry will be accepted on day of feis.
