



Another Valley city may ditch its golf course

- *Lindsay says it's too costly to maintain*
- *Local businessman might take it over*

The city of Lindsay, in Tulare County, is the latest Central Valley city to say its municipal golf course is too much of a burden.

But rather than close it, Lindsay officials are talking with a local businessman about operating the nine-hole course. Under consideration is leasing the land for a dollar a year to the businessman.

To the north, the city of Stockton is still mulling whether to close

both of its 18-hole golf courses. Under the plan being considered, Swensen Golf Course would be sold to developers for housing and retail space.
