The Joint Legislative Program Evaluation Oversight Committee plans to meet Monday, January 22, to discuss several education topics. The committee, co-chaired by Sen. Brent Jackson (R-Sampson) and Rep. Craig Horn (R-Union), will meet at 1 p.m. in Room 544 of the Legislative Office Building in Raleigh.

The meeting agenda includes a two-hour discussion with the MGT Consulting Group on the Public School Construction Needs Survey and recommendations for funding options for selected school districts.

In addition, the committee will receive several Program Evaluation Division (PED) reports, including the following pertaining to public education:

- Options Exist for Increasing Lottery Proceeds for Education
- Meeting Current Standards for School Nurses Statewide May Cost Up to \$79 Million Annually
- Local Education Funding Dispute Resolution Process Is Effective and Economical, but Litigation Could Be Eliminated.
