

Camp Nurse Job Opening

1 or 2 weeks at The Bishop's Ranch in July 2017



The Bishop's Ranch in Sonoma County seeks a medical professional to serve as the Nurse during two youth programs in July 2017 with 20-50 campers each. Are you or someone you know an RN or higher, available for a week or two in July, and interested to work with youth?

Youth camps at The Bishop's Ranch are called BREAD Camps, standing for Bible Recreation Exploration Adventure Discovery. The ideal Camp Nurse enjoys caring for youth, optimally has experience in a camp setting, and is eager to engage with campers throughout the day via presence at games, activities, and workshops.

When:

- Monday, July 17 – Saturday, July 22 (campers entering grades 4-6) **and/or**
- Sunday, July 23 – Saturday, July 29 (campers entering grades 7-9)
- *Optional Staff Closing:* Saturday, July 29 – Sunday, July 30

Responsibilities:

- Checking campers in at registration to discuss medications and existing conditions with campers and parents
- Keep possession of all medical forms
- Monitor the infirmary
- Maintain relationships with campers with chronic issues during the day
- Dispense medications daily
- Contact parents when necessary for medical concerns or events
- Available to respond to medical emergencies, including transporting campers to outside services if needed

Requirements:

- Hold a degree as a Registered Nurse or Physician
- Pass a background check
- Full attendance for the week(s) of camp hired

Compensation:

- \$750 per week
- Room and board onsite (rather tasty food, with cookbooks sold often to guests)
- Children of the Nurse may attend any camp session for free
- Family members of the Nurse may also receive room and board for the week
