

Nearly 100 Ohio Clergy Urge Sen. Portman to Reject the Nomination of Sen. Jeff Sessions for U.S. Attorney General

When in the course of a nation's life it becomes necessary to defend our brothers and sisters against unjust laws and systems, people of faith and good will are compelled by the shared values of justice, dignity, compassion, love of neighbor and love of country to join together in moral resistance to misguided rulers. We face such a moment today.

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all people are created equal, that they are endowed by their creator with inherent dignity and inalienable freedoms, including but not limited to the freedom to vote without obstacle or barrier, the freedom from harassment or targeting by hate groups or law enforcement, the freedom to organize for fairness and respect in the workplace, the freedom to pray and practice one's faith without fear, and freedom from violence and discrimination on the basis of race, gender, sexual orientation, immigration status or economic status.

When those who wield the power of the state deprive the people of these freedoms, whether actively or tacitly, they surrender their moral and political legitimacy. Unfortunately, many serving at the highest levels of our government have compromised themselves and their offices by committing such acts. They must be resisted and held accountable.

Senator Jeff Sessions, who awaits Senate confirmation for Attorney General of the United States -- the nation's highest law enforcement office -- must be rejected. His positions, record and rhetoric reveal him to be a threat to the freedoms we hold dear, not a defender of them. He has subjected civil rights workers to unjust prosecution. He has sat idly by as the Supreme Court and then politicians across the country dismantled voting rights and intentionally erected numerous and varied barriers to voting. He has been one of Congress's most stalwart opponents to common-sense, compassionate reform of our unjust immigration laws. He has legitimized demagogues who demonize Muslims, even receiving an award from a group that exists to manufacture conspiracy theories against Islam. In sum, Senator Sessions perpetuates systemic racism and casts his lot with those who foment bigotry. Confirming him as Attorney General would ensure that the worst of America's past will chart America's future.

As people of faith called to do justice, love mercy, welcome the stranger and love our neighbors as ourselves, we affirm and defend the freedoms and dignity of all people who call our nation home. And we unite in moral resistance to those who threaten and harm our brothers and sisters.
