



Position Title: X-Celerated Theatre Teaching Artist (Spring - Summer 2017)

Program Description:

The Magik Theatre is currently seeking a male teaching artist to instruct programming at rehabilitative treatment facilities for young men.

The mission of the X-celerated Theatre program is to incorporate theatre into the the counseling that participating youth receive. This instructor must be compassionate, committed to the mission of the program, and have experience working with youth from socio-economically disadvantaged communities. The teaching artist will be responsible for differentiating and implementing curriculum, recruiting, and production development with assistance from The Magik Theatre staff.

This program often works with current or previous justice-involved residents from the Bexar County Juvenile Treatment and Detention Centers.

Qualifications:

- Must be 21 years or older
- Must be able to pass a rigorous background check
- Experience working with at socioeconomically disadvantaged youth
- 2 years of teaching experience or professional teaching training
- Associates Degree or higher preferred
- Directorial experience a plus
- Organized and able to execute curriculum on a compressed timeline
- Must have reliable transportation

Time Commitment:

This contract is part-time and provides travel reimbursement.

X-celerated Teaching Artists must be available 2 days a week, Monday – Friday, between the hours of 4 – 6 PM. Teaching Artists are expected to commit to a one-day mandatory training (date pending) and attend meetings with the Program Manager. Some locations will require an end-of-semester sharing which may fall outside of the typical instructional day.

Due to the rehabilitative progress of the youth we work with, we ask Teaching Artist attend every class with minimal exceptions.

Stipend: X-celerated Teaching Artists earn a stipend for the entire semester. Stipend amounts based on experience.
