Goosefoot to Present South Whidbey School Farms with \$50,000

ANGLEY, Whidbey Island, WA (June 5, 2018) – Goosefoot is proud to continue supporting the South Whidbey School Farms with a \$50,000 grant to be presented on Thursday, June 14 at 3 PM at the Elementary School Farm.

In 2014, 2015, and 2016, Goosefoot, a local non-profit community and economic development organization, ran a challenge grant from the Goose Community Grocer in support of the farm program. Over the three-year matching grant challenge, the community and the Goose together raised \$170,423, all of which went to the School Farms.

“The South Whidbey School Farms are such an important part of our healthy, growing food system on Whidbey,” says Goosefoot Executive Director Sandra Whiting. Because of this, Goosefoot will continue supporting the program next school year with another \$50,000 grant.

In addition to grants from Goosefoot, the success of the garden program hinges on continued support of the community. The School Farms deliver over 1,000 pounds of fresh organic produce to the Chartwells-managed school cafeterias. Students have been able to create salad bars, Taco Tuesdays, and more, all with produce the students grew and picked themselves.

The School Farms have expanded to the high school within the last year as well. A second garden allows for more students to learn about their local food systems, growing more produce for use by the school cafeterias, Good Cheer, and Whidbey Island Nourishes.

Press and the public is invited to attend the check ceremony on Thursday, June 14 at 3 PM at the South Whidbey Elementary School Farm, located at 5476 Maxwelton Road, Langley WA 98260. Free cake, lemonade, carrots, and peas will be available after the presentation of the check.
