



City Council Meeting Debrief

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At the Tuesday, April 11th Meeting of the City Council/City Council Acting as
Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency Meeting the Council:

- Welcomed Jacob Wasso, an Almond Grove Elementary School student to lead the pledge of allegiance
- Presented Martha Carlson, Community Engagement Specialist of Meals on Wheels of Contra Costa with a proclamation
- Recognized the 2017 Entrepreneur Training Class
- Received an update regarding the Contra Costa Water District by Board of Director Connstance Holdaway
- Heard an update from Diablo Water District provided by General Manager Mike Yeraka
- Awarded the construction contract associated with Capital Improvement Project 192 which will make improvements ranging from signal updates, striping modifications, camera installation, street name installation etc. at five intersections
- Accepted as complete work associated with Capital Improvement Project 183 that made storm drain improvements at Brock Lane
- Approved the payment for equipment, material, and labor for the construction of a parking lot on city owned property between the railroad tracks and Downtown businesses from Norcross Ln and O'Hara Ave
- Authorized an agreement that would allow for the contractor performing street sweeping services to park and store equipment at a city property for lease until they find a more permanent office
- Accepted as the reports from the recent audit, as required by the Single Audit Act and Office of Management and Budget standards
- Approved an amendment to the minutes of the Tuesday, March 24th city council meeting that more accurately reflects the Ad Hoc Committee's comments related to Community Choice Energy. The Committee made a finding rather than a recommendation on the topic.
- Received the third quarter report on the Capital Improvement Program from Kevin Rohani, Public Works Director/City Engineer

- Held a work session to provide the applicant feedback regarding a potential amendment of the General Plan land use designation from multi-family residential and commercial to only multi-family residential at 3300 Neroly Rd
