On **Tuesday, August 7th**, Oakley will join over 16,000 communities from all 50 states in celebrating the 35th National Night Out.

National Night Out is an annual community-building campaign that promotes police/community partnerships and neighborhood camaraderie to make Oakley an even more safe, more caring place to live.

National Night Out is a chance for Oakley residents to get to know each other and their law enforcement officers in a positive, causal environment that promotes civic pride. Events include safety demonstrations, youth events, visits from emergency personnel, and much more.

During the National Night Out, residents are encouraged to lock their doors, turn on their outside lights and spend the evening outside with neighbors. Whether it's a barbecue, ice cream social or potluck, National Night Out celebrations are a great opportunity to spend time with your neighbors to promote a stronger, safer environment for you and your family.

The Oakley Police Department would love to stop by and say "hi" at any events you may be hosting and would appreciate advance notice if there will be an organized event in your neighborhood.
