## Southeastern Regional Relocation Council (SRRC) 2016-2017 Scholarship Application

### Background

The Southeastern Regional Relocation Council (SRRC) is a non-profit organization that provides corporate and service industry relocation professionals the opportunity to meet and work together on a regular basis to educate, to learn and to share knowledge and experiences about current relocation practices and emerging relocation issues in an effort to better serve and address the diverse needs of relocating employees and their families. As part of our commitment to Relocation, the SRRC has developed a scholarship program for current high school seniors who have been relocated to Florida sometime between grades 9 (after 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation) and 12. **The one-time award will be presented to an area high school senior this year (Residence eligibility is defined as a senior attending a public school in any city or county district within the state of Florida).** The award will be sent to the college that the student will be attending to assist with tuition, etc.

The SRRC organization will select the scholarship winner based on the strength of their total application. The student will be evaluated on academic performance, extra-curricular activities, and on their response to an essay addressing the challenges associated with relocating to a new area and a new high school.

### Requirements

#### **Applicants must meet these requirements:**

- Currently a senior in good standing in a Florida high school.
- Has relocated more than 50 miles and changed schools due to their family's relocation between grades 9 and 12
- Currently have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on a scale of 4.0 (or equivalent if different scale)
- Must provide SAT/ACT scores (documented)

**Please submit the following information, along with your completed application, signed by your Guidance Department:**

- 1) Please list (on a separate sheet) all your extra-curricular activities & work experience during high school.
- 2) Please write an essay addressing the following:

Tell us about your experiences associated with your relocation to Florida. Please feel free to discuss your family background, challenges encountered with the relocation, and successes achieved. We would also appreciate any advice you would give to another teenager preparing to relocate (as you did)! The essay should be between 1,000 to 1,500 words and must be **e-mailed in a Word document format**.

**Deadline for applications must be received by February 3, 2017 to have time for evaluation and selection. The scholarship announcement will be made at our spring meeting in March. The winner will be asked to present their essay in a video for our meeting attendees to view.**
