

It's no longer your Grandfather's Muskoka: How and Why our Environment is Changing?



We live in a world which is radically different than it used to be throughout most of recorded history, and one that continues to change – climate change is the most obvious but not the only aspect of this change. The changes are occurring because of human activities locally and globally, and local action can ameliorate them, although concerted global action over long spans of time is needed to bring them fully under control. These changes are beginning to have important implications for our lives in Muskoka. Dr. Sale will use the Muskoka Watershed Council's recent report on climate change to illustrate what we can expect here over the next 2-4 decades, and the kinds of action we should take if we want to retain the beautiful, healthy environment and the lifestyle we now enjoy.
