Lake of Bays Heritage Foundation Annual General Meeting – Saturday August 18

Join us for our AGM at Bethune Memorial Church in Baysville. This year we are featuring:

- The community history of Kerrimuir Road. A video will be shown and the Foundation's Heritage plaques will be presented to a number of residents. A guided walking tour of some of the buildings on Kerrimuir Road will follow lunch.
- The Save Turtles At Risk Today (START) program. Jeff Hathaway, founder of Scales Nature Park and coordinator of START Muskoka will present live turtles and give a talk.
- A selection of Cameron Peck's photographs compiled by Mark McLean. Between 1935 and 1952, Peck, a boat enthusiast, collected 1500 photos of vintage navigation boats, the Portage Flyer and boats from his personal collection. Mark will talk about the archives and show a selection of images he reprinted using the platinum-palladium process. Invented in the 1850s, this technique is still considered the best archival medium for photographic prints.

Join us for coffee 10:30AM. The meeting starts at 11:00, followed by a light lunch and a guided walking tour of Kerrimuir Road.
