A Program Planning Packet has been prepared for each Scouting unit in Capitol Area Council Districts. Pick up your 2017-2018 planning packet at your district's Program Planning Kick-off/Roundtable.

STRONG PACKS HAVE

- 1- **Annual Pack Program** planned a year in advance that is shared with every family as a calendar
 - a. Gather school dates; community event dates; charter organization dates; district and council dates; collect Family Talent Survey Sheets and review last year's pack program calendar.

- 2- **Annual Pack Program Budget**
 - a. Basic expense includes: registration fees; Boys' Live; insurance; advancement/recognition; activities; day camp; resident camp; program materials; full uniforms; reserve fund.
