

September 2018 – Central NY Salmon River Group Fishing Trip



Located in Pulaski, NY not far from Syracuse and only a short drive from major East Coast cities, the world famous Salmon River is renowned for its salmon (King & Coho) and steelhead runs. The peak of salmon fishing season happens when the spawning run occurs. From the second half of September to the middle of October, salmon fill the streams in pods of 10 to 200. At times, there are so many salmon in the river, you'd think you could walk across it without ever touching the river bottom. The Chinook (King) Salmon range from 15 to 35 pounds, while the Coho Salmon that enter the river at the same time average 12 to 15 lbs. These salmon can be very aggressive when they do take a fly.

Lodging and guides book up over a year in advance for peak weeks on the Salmon River, but DSC Northeast has locked up a limited number of spots for this September to make available for some of its members to enjoy this world class fishery.

Trip Dates/Schedule:

- **Friday, September 21:** Arrive lodge late afternoon/early evening
- **Saturday, September 22 & Sunday, September 23:** Two full days guided fishing on the Salmon River. Primary quarry is the King Salmon, with scattered Coho and perhaps an occasional rainbow or brown trout mixed in as well.
- **Sunday, September 23:** Depart late afternoon/early evening

Included:

- Semi-private accommodations in lodge located right on the Salmon River in the heart of all the fishing action. Each room houses 2-4 persons with shared bath, sitting room, and living room with TV, fireplace and WiFi.
- Experienced Guide (minimum 1x1, maximum 3x1 angler-to-guide ratio)
- All fishing tackle and gear (except waders, sunscreen, any other desired misc. personal items)

Not Included:

- Meals (various local dining options are available)
- NY State Fishing License
- Tips/Gratuities

Cost (2 Nights Lodging & 2 Full Days Fishing):

- 1x1 Guide – \$890
- 2x1 Guide – \$550
- 3x1 Guide – \$500
