Memorial Hospital is excited to let you know that our Junior Medical School (JMS) program is back! Last year was an incredible success and we hope to do the same (if not better!) this year. JMS is a 3-day, immersive program designed to give your students a full view of the many different aspects of a healthcare career. It is available to junior and senior students with a GPA of 3.0 or higher who have an interest in a healthcare career. It is also open to 2018 graduated seniors may also apply.

From physicians to nurses, from rehab to palliative care, students will be exposed to professionals in their field to hear about what the job entails, the educational requirements and the “typical day”. The program offers roundtable discussions, hands-on activities, department tours and other engaging sessions to expand their understanding of the hospital environment. To apply, go to <https://www.uchealth.org/give-to-uchealth/volunteer/> (scroll down a bit to the Junior Med application) and requires a \$25.00 fee. Two Letters of Recommendation must also be submitted within 5 days of the application date. If accepted, the program cost is \$150.00 which includes food and a program shirt. Some scholarships will be available. In total, there are 4 sessions available with 2 application deadlines. There is a maximum of 15 students per session. Students may apply to just 1 (one) session. The entire program has only 60 openings and the competition is tough! **Complete** applications should include the aforementioned elements (a completed application, fee and letters of recommendation) and meet appropriate deadlines. And as a helpful hint: Well developed and presented student essays are a good start!
