



Apollo's Fire will light up the BBHHS stage this October 12th!

This October 12th will be the return of the famed Apollo's Fire to perform "A Night at Bach's Coffeehouse", an evening of exciting music by Bach and his colleagues. The program led by director/harpsichordist Jeanette Sorrell, will transport the audience to 18th century Leipzig, where a famous coffeehouse was the scene of virtuoso concerts by Bach and his student orchestra. Numbers include Bach's Brandenburgs no. 4 and 5, as well as works by Bach's admired colleagues, Telemann, Vivaldi and Handel. Sparks will fly as Apollo's Fire performs Sorrell's arrangement of Vivaldi's "La Folia" (Madness) from memory. This is the 25th anniversary season for Apollo's Fire.

Tickets are on sale now at \$20 for general admission seating in the BBHHS auditorium. All proceeds will benefit the BBHHS Orchestra program to enrich the musical experiences of the students.

The concert on Thursday, October 13th begins at 7pm in the BBHHS Main Gym, and admission is free.
