Students are required to complete approximately 12 hours of self-paced online pre-course work prior to the first day of class. The 10-week course of instruction will begin Monday September 11, 2017, with one week of classroom instruction followed by one week of facilitated distance learning. Students will have a two week break prior to the next two weeks of instruction. The course schedule is:

October 30 - Nov 3, 2017 - Classroom Learning
November 27- Dec 1, 2017 - Distance Learning

January 8 - 12, 2018 - Distance Learning
January 22 - 26, 2018 - Classroom Learning
February 26 - March 2, 2018 - Distance Learning
March 5 - 9, 2018 - Classroom Learning
