Wee Builders
(3 – 4 years):
Coloured Ice Sculptures



What you need:

- Ice cube trays
- Small food or storage containers
- Food Colouring
- Bottle of Water



What to do:

1. Mix various food colours with water and pour into ice cube trays and containers and let them freeze over night to get strong solid ice to build with.
2. Remove ice from trays and containers.
3. Start building ice sculptures when the weather is below zero Celsius, as the ice will take longer to melt.
4. The secret ingredient to bind the cubes together is water. As the children are putting two cubes together, dribble or spray little water on the cubes and have the children count to 10. As the children are counting the water is freezing and acting as a glue to bind the cubes together. Continue the same process until they are finished building their sculpture.
