

They returned to the United States in July 2018, and JJ is now serving in a newly created role as Refugee Ministries Coordinator for the RCA Global Missions. JJ is thankful to have seen the image of God reflected so diversely in the faces of those to whom and with whom she served abroad, and we invite you to learn from JJ about her experience in **"caring for those seeking refuge."**

Freedom in Ministry is centered on Worship - with Friday hymn sings and Sunday morning communion. This year our worship leader will be the Rev. Amy Nyland the Executive Minister of the Regional Synod of New York. The weekend will feature Rest and Renewal with Saturday afternoon fire side chats; conversations around dining tables and talent sharing; and Discovery - with an educational component for ministers and their spouses/partners.
