KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Some of the main position duties are listed below. Other duties may be assigned as necessary.

- Responsible for conducting the full range of activities required to research, prepare, submit, and manage event proposals for fundraising and donor events.
- Perform prospect research on foundations and corporations to evaluate prospects for corporate and foundation ongoing fundraising relationship opportunities.
- Work with staff members to plan and execute community partners and member events, including the Starfish Dash, an official Fiesta event.
- Maintain records in database, digital, and paper files, including donation tracking.
- Create, plan, and execute fundraising event as part of long-term design project.

KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS:

- Strong written and verbal communication skills required to communicate with members and potential donors.
- Strong time-management skills, attention to detail, and ability to meet deadlines.
- Preferred experience with event planning, but not required.
- Strong contributor in team environments

QUALIFICATIONS:

- General knowledge of event planning preferred, but not required.
- Previous experience with non-profit fundraising preferred, but not required.
- Experience working in deadline-driven environments.
- Able to work well in a team environment, handle multiple assignments and meet deadlines.
