

- 1) **Aux Vignerondes**: More down-to-earth wines come from Faiveley from this sub region.
- 2) **Aux Chaignots**: There is a choice of no less than four top cuvées from this great vineyard & Faiveley is one of them.
- 3) **Les Damodes**: A common, highly reliable Premier Cru for outstanding wine & Faiveley is namely one of them.
- 4) **Les Pruliers**: Vines go back 50 years and are planted in a dark organic, gravelly soil. Yields classic, complete Nuits that combines power, freshness, richness and minerality.
- 5) **Les St-Georges**: This would be Nuits-St-Georges' Grand Cru, if it had one. Faiveley is similarly elegant, although fresher and drinkable early. Worthy of aging.
- 6) **Les Porrets St-Georges**: Faiveley style display elegant, fresher and drinkable early and are worthy of age.

Faiveley NSG 1er Aux Vignerondes 2012	"...A bright, juicy version, with spiced cherry, currant, earth, licorice and light vegetal flavors. Dense, lingering with grainy tannins and a minerally aftertaste. Very fluid, resonant and long. Best from 2019 through 2033 ..."
Faiveley NSG 1er Aux Vignerondes 2013	"...Bony, offering spiced cherry, currant and floral notes enhanced by bracing acidity. Shows the promise of ripe, juicy fruit and fine length, but needs time to integrate. Best from 2019 through 2030..."
Faiveley NSG 1er Aux Vignerondes 2014	"...A core of violet and black currant notes marks this intense, brooding red. The vivid acidity creates tension, while the dense tannins provide a matrix of support for the red and black fruit, tobacco, spice and mineral flavors. Fine length. Best from 2020 through 2035..."
Faiveley NSG 1er Cru Aux Chaignots 2011	"...a classic Chaignots to shine along with the supported red and dark berry fruit and earth components. There is a lovely texture to the supple and round middle weight flavors that are blessed plenty of dry extract that coats the mouth on the delicious, balanced and lightly mineral-infused finish..."
Faiveley NSG 1er Cru Aux Chaignots 2012	"...There is a lush and distinctly spicy character to the solidly dense medium-bodied flavors that are shaped by phenolically mature tannins on the mildly austere finish that displays fine depth and very good length. Solid quality here..."
Faiveley NSG 1er Cru Aux Chaignots 2013	"...There is good richness but also good delineation to the delicious and lightly mineral-inflected flavors that possess a mouth coating finish. This well-balanced effort is very Nuits in basic character but with no overt rusticity..."
Faiveley NSG 1er Cru Aux Chaignots 2014	"...there is lovely detail and verve to the medium-bodied flavors that exude a fine minerality on to the moderately rustic and attractively complex finale. This too should be approachable young if desired..."
Faiveley NSG 1er Cru Les Damodes 2011	"...A spicy, fresh and mildly exotic nose of tea, wild red berries and plenty of pungent earth gives way to more obvious mineral-inflected flavors that possess a taut muscularity on the balanced, understated and attractively persistent finish. Even with the muscle, this is essentially a wine of finesse as the supporting tannins are really quite fine..."
Faiveley NSG 1er Cru Les Damodes 2012	"...An overtly spicy nose of cool and earthy aromas of red currant and elegant floral notes. There is good delineation to the supple and vibrant medium weight flavors that possess a taut muscularity on the lightly mineral-inflected finish. This harmonious effort delivers fine length in a package that should amply reward mid to longer-term cellaring..."

Faiveley NSG 1er Cru Les Damodes 2013	"...There is fine richness to the very round and attractively textured medium-bodied flavors where the minerality is a bit more pronounced on the relatively powerful finish that is slightly longer though slightly less complex..."
Faiveley NSG 1er Cru Les Damodes 2014	"...There is a lovely inner mouth perfume to the concentrated, intense and more muscular middle weight flavors that possess a velvety and seductive mouth feel before terminating in a balanced and slightly rustic finale. In sum this is Nuits in style but a civilized Nuits..."
Faiveley NSG 1er Cru les Pruliers 2014	"...Enticing flavors of smoky black cherry, blackberry and violet are the hallmarks of this suave red. Picks up spice accents as the firm structure asserts itself on the lingering finish. Once the oak is absorbed, this should rock. Best from 2020 through 2035..."
Faiveley NSG 1er Cru les St Georges 2011	"...There is a very classy mouth feel to the refined medium-bodied flavors that are supported by notably fine-grained tannins on the dusty, deep, complex and exceptionally long finish. This is a wine of high quality plus it's very stylish..." Rated Sweet Spot outstanding ♥
Faiveley NSG 1er Cru les St Georges 2013	"This is both more aromatically complex and more elegant with its restrained, pure and beautifully well-layered nose of assorted red berries, earth, floral, game and tea scents. There is a relatively refined mouth feel to the robust yet refined middle weight flavors that possess plenty of tannin-buffering dry extract, all wrapped in a balanced and impressively long finish where a touch of wood appears..." Faiveley NSG 1er Cru les St Georges 2014	"...There is excellent power, punch and delineation to the more mineral-inflected medium weight plus flavors that exhibit excellent persistence on the beautifully well-balanced finish. This is a combination of muscle and grace as the power is delivered without weight. Worth checking out..." Rated Sweet Spot outstanding ♥
Faiveley NSG 1er Cru Porets St Georges 2012	"There is excellent complexity to the well-layered nose of red pinot fruit, cherry, plum, earth and sandalwood. I very much like the mouth feel to the ripe and enveloping medium-bodied flavors that brim with dry extract that really coats the palate on the muscular and powerful finish...."
Faiveley NSG 1er Cru Porets St Georges 2013	"...As it virtually always is this is bigger, richer and more powerful with fine mid-palate concentration that helps to buffer the slightly firmer and more rustic tannins on the impressively complex and persistent finish..."
Faiveley NSG 1er Cru Porets St Georges 2014	"...The appealingly textured, intense, detailed and vibrant middle weight flavors possess a completely different mouth feel while delivering a lingering, complex and more obviously austere finale..."
