Be a part of the fun Sunday mornings during the 10:00 service! Children begin in church for the 10:00 service and exit for Church School when cued by the acolyte with the cross prior to the reading of the Gospel. The children return to receive communion when it is offered. Primary school classes are held in the two bright, renovated classrooms and the middle school class is held in the choir room. All of these rooms are below the fellowship hall. In 2017, we have averaged 16 children total per classroom day. Our program is non-cumulative, so students and visitors can drop in and not feel like they've joined the party mid-stream. Parents are welcome to sit in on the classes if that makes their child more comfortable. Visitors are always welcome.
