Edmonton Transit fare adjustments for 2018

Starting February 1, 2018:

Adult or DATS monthly pass	\$94.25	\$97.00
Senior monthly pass	\$15.00	\$15.50
Post-secondary monthly pass**	\$86.00	\$88.50
Route 747 monthly pass***	\$100.00	\$100.00

The Ride Transit program subsidized monthly pass remains at \$35.00. The senior annual pass fare adjustment takes effect for the April 2018-March 2019 pass. The new rate for the senior annual pass is \$136.50 (from \$132.50) and the low-income senior annual pass will cost \$59.25 (from \$57.50) effective April 1. The Youth Monthly Pass will increase to \$75.00 (from \$73.00) starting September 1.

Types of ETS passes

*Day Pass	Up to four children (ages 12 and under) accompanied by an adult can ride ETS all day, including transfers.
**Post-secondary monthly pass	Offers a discount to students of recognized post-secondary institutions.
***Route 747 monthly pass	For travel between Edmonton International Airport and Century Park LRT station only

Edmonton transit fares remain competitive with those in other municipalities of a similar size. Edmonton's adult monthly pass is \$97.00 and single fare is \$3.25. Calgary's adult monthly pass fare is \$103 and single fare is \$3.30. Ottawa offers an adult monthly pass for \$116.50 and single fare is \$3.50.
