- At least 50% of frontline staff participate in training
- Management required to attend training
- Team leader appointed as a liaison
- Open to discussion regarding environment changes to enhance safety
- Commitment to share training with new hires and those who weren't able to attend the original training
- Agreement to annual on-site follow-up visits
