Burglaries 018th District Near North

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to residents of the 018th District of recently reported burglary related incidents on Beats 1813, 1814, and 1821. In each incident, the victims left their garage doors open or unlocked in which bicycles and a motor vehicle were stolen.

Incident times and locations:

- 1600 block of North Bissell St., Tuesday, March 28, 2017 during the late evening to early morning hours.
- 300 block of West Concord Place, Thursday, March 16th and 23rd, 2017 in the early evening hours.
- 1900 block of North Cleveland Ave., Saturday, March 25, 2017 in the late evening hours to early morning hours
- 1800 block of North Orleans St., Friday, March 31, 2017 in the early afternoon hours
- 200 block of West Scott St., Monday, April 10, 2017 at 7:08pm
- 400 block of West North Ave., Saturday, April 8, 2017 at 10:30am

About the Offenders:

Male, African American offender wearing black hat, black jacket with red lettering, blue jeans, and black gym shoes which was captured on surveillance video. During another incident, a male African American offender is seen wearing a black White Sox cap, black hooded sweatshirt, and black pants. The offender is seen loading the bicycle into a grey Chevy Impala which was captured on video surveillance.

What you can do:

- Keep doors locked and windows secure.
- Immediately repair broken windows, doors, or locks.
- If video surveillance is available, save and make a copy of the incident for investigating Detectives.
- If you are a victim, do not touch anything and contact the police immediately.
- Keep a record of property serial numbers.
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of any suspicious people including any vehicle description and license plate information.
