

GRANT QUICK FACTS

Impact 100 Chicago recognizes the many organizations that are doing important work improving the lives of individuals and communities in the Chicagoland area. To support this work and allow organizations to "dream big," Impact 100 Chicago annually awards \$100,000 grants to local nonprofit organizations.

We Value

- Awarding high impact grants that have a transformative effect on the receiving organizations and those they serve.
- Funding in five categories: Family, Education, Health, Sustainability and Culture.
- Providing ways for our members to gain firsthand knowledge of non-profits in our community.

Grant Requirements

The applying organization must:

- Be classified as a "Public Charity" with tax-exempt status under section 501(c)3.
- Provide services in one or more of the following counties: Cook, DuPage, Grundy, Kane, Kendall, Lake, McHenry, and Will.
- Be in operation for a minimum of 36 months prior to applying for the grant and have an operating budget, including in kind donations, between \$500,000 and \$3 million. Impact 100 Chicago accepts applications that support or expand the impact of a proven program, or that propose a new project that will have such an impact.

Additional requirements are listed at **Eligibility Requirements**.

Application access opens October 2, 2017 through our website.

Letters of Inquiry are due November 17, 2017.
