What is Home & School - FAQs

What is Home and School?

Home and School is St. James's version of PTA. This is a great way to meet other parents and get involved within the St. James community.

When are meetings and how long do they last?

Meetings are once a month, usually the second Thursday of the month at 5:30 in the Resource Room. They last anywhere from 1-2 hours depending on the items on the agenda, but feel free to leave sooner if needed.

Is it OK if I bring my kids?

Absolutely. Most of us that come have our kids there for a little while at least. The kids usually work on homework, play on handheld devices if they have one, and eat their dinner (McDonalds and Rocky's are within a couple blocks). We are willing to do more with additional participation from families too.

Do I have to go to all the meetings to be a part of Home and School?

Absolutely not. It is completely fine to come to one a meeting a year or every meeting, whatever works within your schedule. We have our officers and 2 teacher representatives (all teachers take turns on a rotating basis throughout the year) that are present at meetings.

What does Home and School do or talk about at meetings?

Home and School helps plan community building events throughout the school year. For example, we have sponsored Back to School night at Vitense, the All School Dance, chili and salsa competitions, Cookie Rolling, and educational opportunities. We fund extra materials and supplies for teachers and around the school, and plan our annual FUNdraisers, the Spartan Stampede.

How does Home and School get their money?

The Spartan Stampede is our biggest fundraiser and takes place every fall in October, the Spaghetti Dinner that takes place in the winter, and the SCRIP program that runs all year long (yes, all 12 months).

Scrip Highlights – Family Budgets

With 50% of your earned Scrip rebates coming back to you as a tuition credit in April, you can earn hundreds of dollars each year! Last year, 2 of our school families earned over \$900 in tuition credit simply by buying Scrip regularly! WOW!
