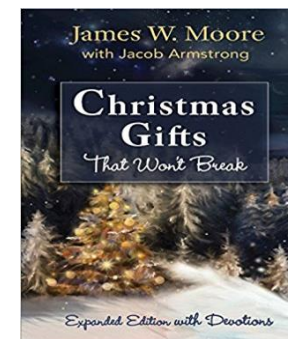
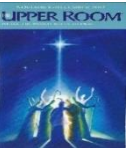
"FUMC" BIBLE BITES
